



As the only inpatient pediatric rehabilitation program in Oklahoma, staff in the Pediatric Medical Rehabilitation Unit (PMRU) care for children and teenagers in need of acute rehabilitation due to a traumatic or congenital injury, sudden illness, or post-surgical recovery. Patients, families, and staff collaborate to create an individualized plan to optimize mobility, healing, and independence. The CARF - accredited unit serves patients from newborn to 20 years of age. After an initial assessment, our team will collaborate with the patient and family to create an individualized, goal-oriented plan to transition the patient back home. The average length of stay in the PMRU is 25 days, and is determined by each patient's diagnosis, goals, and needs.

Physicians and nurse practitioners lead our team in providing patients with 24-hour medical care, respiratory therapy and a customized program consisting of physical therapy, occupational therapy and speech-language therapy.
