# Pediatric Medical Rehabilitation Unit Program Overview

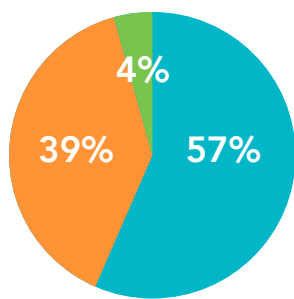


The Pediatric Medical Rehabilitation Unit (PMRU) serves patients from across Oklahoma and the surrounding states. The PMRU is a 20 bed inpatient unit. Since 2009, PMRU has been accredited by CARF as a Comprehensive Integrated Rehabilitation Pediatric Specialty Program. CARF International (Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities) is an accreditation that assures the public of our commitment to continually enhance the quality of services and programs with a focus on the satisfaction of the persons served.

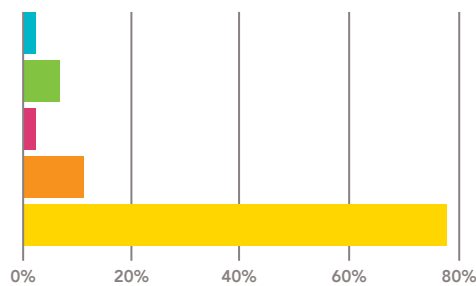
## Provision of Services

Each patient will receive a minimum of 3 hours of therapeutic intervention per day that will be individualized according to the patient's needs and tolerance. Therapy may include PT, OT, Speech Therapy, Recreational Therapy, Music Therapy, Education, or Behavioral Health Services.

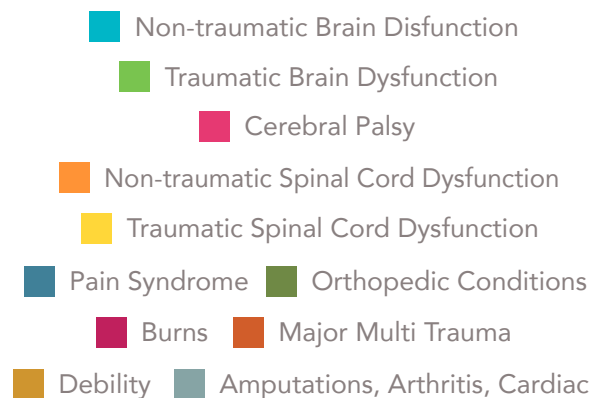
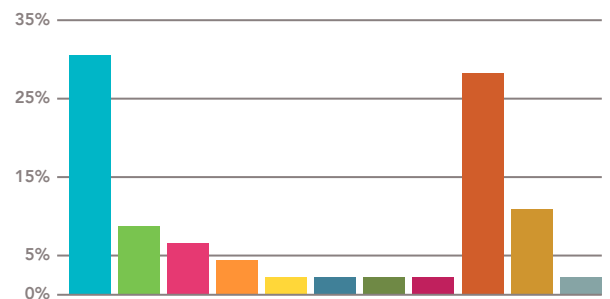
### Payer Mix

## Outcomes

Total Gain Score (improvements measured by the rehabilitative team during the admission, utilizing a measurement tool called the WeeFim) was 26.8 as compared to a national average at similar facilities of 22.6.
