| Patient Mixing | Two designated units may mix. Both floors of tower may mix. | No internal unit mixing restrictions Outpatients may mix with inpatients in outdoor settings | No mixing restrictions |
| Patient Precautions | Distancing 6 feet between patients. Mask worn by patients appropriate and safe to mask. | Distancing 6 feet between patients Mask worn by patient appropriate and safe to mask | Standard precautions |
| Outings / Community events | One child per vehicle /remain in vehicle outings only | Outdoor outings and home studies, permitted with no close community interaction. External individuals or groups presenting, must follow masking guidelines and have minimal contact with patients | Outings, BPS, ADL community programming, and other community interaction opportunities permitted. |
| Therapeutic leaves | Therapeutic leaves <i>to home</i> with private room isolation period and testing. (5 days, DROPLET plus respirator) | Therapeutic leaves <i>to home</i> may return to multi-pt. units with 5 days droplet isolation and testing. (DROPLET, respirator not required) Droplet isolation for private rooms; if patient can wear a mask properly may leave room for activities. | Therapeutic leaves <i>to home</i> , may return to multi-pt. units with 48 hours droplet isolation / observation |
| ** Family visits | Family room visits of 5 household members. (no food) Bedside limit of 2 visitors. <i>Those age 5 and up may visit bedside when properly wearing a mask</i> | Family room visits limit of 5 persons (no food) Bedside visits allowed up to 3 persons. <i>Those age 5 and up may visit bedside when properly wearing a mask</i> | no restrictions on the number of visitors or on the age of the visitor, from a COVID perspective, as long as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minors are not left alone. • No tolerance policy and family manual rules are abided by. • Visitors are staying out of other patients' rooms and bedspaces. |
| Staff and Facility activities (external visitors) | Social distance and follow masking levels as posted at entrances | Social distance and follow masking levels as posted at entrances | |
